

"KILLED IN ACTION, 17.9.18."

We were in the Boiseries stune. Condron was shot by a sniper just at dusk and killed outright. I saw him after he was killed. He was buried, as far as I know, between Boiseries and Chaulnes Junction, in a little cemetery there. I did not see it.

He was in "D" Company, and in my Platoon. He was about 19 years of age, and about 5'7" in height.
