

I saw him blown to pieces by a shell at the Windmill, Pozieres on 6th August. I knew him well and came from Australia with him. He was in A. Company - a middleaged man, but one of the best.

*Colgan's body was found about the end of February this year. I was there when his remains were found. They were unrecognisable but we took his disc and pay book. The pay book was illegible. The disc was handed in. This was at Pozieres."
