Informant states " I fear there is no doubt whatever that Love was killed on Nov. 14/16. in the attack we made on Gird Trench to the left of the Flers. We went over at 7.a.m. it was unsuccessful and we withdrew. We never got near enough to the enemy to have any prisoners taken. Any man not accounted for that day must have been killed. He must lie on No Mans Land. "
