He was in B.Coy. I knew him well, he used to be in my Company. He was about 5 feet 10, about 21, dark. On the 15th April we were at Hangard Wood. Pte Patfield of the 18th Battn B.Coy. (who was with the Battn when I left on the 9th May) told me that Lawrie was killed. He gave me no particulars.
