

I was wounded at he bars 3 weeks ago. There is some error of date. I am sure of my man."

He comes from Ballens, Richmond River, N.S.Wales, and was in A.Coy. He, anderson and enother man were caught by the same shall of Flers last Revember. Anderson was wounder and Leonard and the other man were killed outright. Anderson has just come back to us. I wrote and told Leonard's mother some two or three months ago, and when we were having a spell, I took a friend of Leonard's people who had some out afterwards, to show him the tombstone which we had put up over his grave near the trench where he was killed.
