" I saw Ellis wounded by a shell'while we were working at Delville Wood, on Dec. 20th., 'I6. He was taken to the dress ing station at Quarry siding, near Benafay, and died there on some date early in February1917. He was buried in the cemetery close to the dressing station, and later on I saw his grave. It had a cross erected over it, bearing his name, number, and battalion. I knew him well, and wexe were in the same battalion for about I2xx months".

I am not absolutely certain, but I think he is buried in Bernafay Wood.
