

He came from M.S. Wales, near the border by the river Murray. His father I think, owned a big station. He was going to his dug-out from the gim-pits, Spoth Bank, when a shell dropped and burst near him, killing him and another man and nounding some more. His body was brought to the waggon line where I was at the time and we buried him at Dickebusch Cemetery, just near the church.

I knew Sgt Lealie for 15 months up to time he was killed, which was on July 29th at Speil Bank. I was told soon after by the new of his bettery that he had first of all been wounded by high explosive, after which while waking his way to degree, about 40 yards off, to take cover from the chelling and to get his wound dressed, he was cought by a shell and billed instantaneously. He was buried at Bickiebusch in some grave as Gar Pringle, with a cross with their manes on, and a chain kept in placeby 4 pegs round the grave, in the military demetery.

I saw hid body just after he was killed close to Hill 60 at Spoil Bank Mpyes. He was killed by a shell, death instantaneous. I was at his burial in Hilitary Cemetery, Dickiebush, by Church of England Captain and a cross was erected on his grave. He was a farmer in Victoria. I was in the Batty with him for 18 months in Egypt and France. He had dancing blue eyes, dark complexion and very lively, always smiling.

" Mr. Zillebeke, I was back with the maggon lines - on July 29, 1917 and we were in direct communication with our hattery, our duty being to keep it supplied with emmunition, etc. They were being heavily shelled and the men ran for shelter and while running. Sgt. Leslie was killed by shrapnel. Sgt. Heritage out up a beautiful cross to his memory in Dickebusch Cemetery, carved by a Battery Corporal, with the Australian rising sun and a brass modallion. I attended Leslie's funeral, he lies next to Prindle. "
