I knew them all personal personally as they were in my platoon. We were in our first line trench and had orders to take Mouquet Farm. They got into the trench but the Germans came up from behind and they all got cut off. The Sergt. and all his men took shelter in shell holes and all fought to a finish. He thinks the majority of them were killed as they were determined not to be taken alive.
