I know Kilpatrick, he and I used to share the same dug-out. He was killed in Sept. 1916 on Hill 60, being shot through the head. I helped bury him the same day. He was the only man of that name in the 8th L.H. and was about 5 ft 6, dark and thickset. He had been in the 2nd Reinforcements and we called him Joe. I am quite certain that this is the man enquired for.
