Kelly was killed with 7 or 8 others, by a shell, in a pill-box at Menin Road. He was in the same Pltn. 16th, as myself. I did not see him killed, nor after his death. Pte. Bishop, wounded in Sep. 20th stunt, and came to England, would know:

I saw Kelly blown to pieces by a shell in air attack at Polygon Wood, about 600 yards from the hop-over. When the shell burst I also heard the boys around cry out "There goes poor Kelly". I carried on but believe he was buried in the shell hole afterwards. He was in same Pltn. as I.
