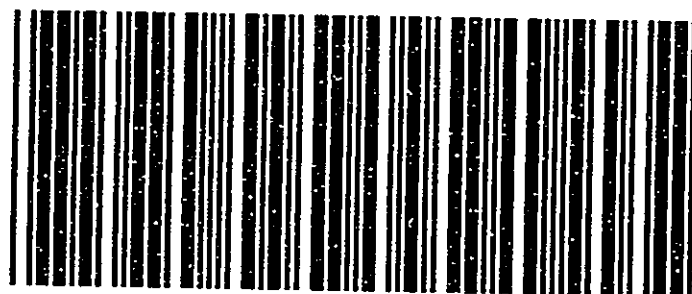

(His Christian name was Marshall, short, fair and had a brother in the same Squad. (B)

Witness saw him going on sick parade and from information received from Ladner's brother he had an abscess on the liver. A few days later witness heard it read out in orders that he had died in Hospital in Jerusalem and heard from the brother, who got leave to go and see him in hospital that he was suffering from pneumonia also, and that he had seen him the day before his death.

Died of Illness 4-6-18

I knew "Marshall" about 12 months-he was in the same troop (No 2 Troop "B" Squadron) as I was up till the time he went away sick. I first struck him at Rafa in Oct. 1917 and in May 1918 when ~~we~~ we were at Solomon's Pools near Bethlehem he took sick and was evacuated to our 1st Brigade Field Ambulance and from there he went to hospital at Jerusalem. He was out there about 6 or 7 days before he died on the evening of the 4th June 1918. He was buried two days later on the 6th. His brother Tom and four of five out of each Troop of the Squadron went to his funeral. He was buried in the Jerusalem Military Cemetery among a lot of others who died or were killed in that locality. He has a nice cross erected by the Regt. and the grave is well laid out. Tom his brother, has a photo of the grave and I am enclosing a photo of the part of the Cemetery in which Marshall's grave can be seen. The big cross with the three black diamonds marks his grave. Marshall was only a young chap about 18 or 19 well liked by all in the Squadron, everybody knew him, he was a good sport, always took part in anything that was going on always high spirited and never down hearted. We were all very sorry when he died. He was a chap about 5'8 and weighed about 10 stone. He was a medium complexioned chap and came from S.A.

At a meeting of the C. M. S. held in the Albert Hall, London on May the 6th a film was shown of your C. M. S. staff in Jerusalem with a statement that you had personally ministered to wounded and dying British Prisoners of War.

This office is still seeking news of Australian Soldiers who became 'missing'.

It is hoped that some of them may have passed through your hands.

It should greatly comfort the relatives of these men to know that their last hours had been ~~spent in your care~~^{for} and that ~~that~~ they had Christian burial.
