# "Eilled 8/8/1918".

We were in action at Villers Bretonneux. We were advancing and just as we got to our objective, Lundie was killed by a machine gun bullet outright. I saw him after he had been killed but cannot say anything about what happened after. Lundie was in "D" Company. I was in the same Battalion and Company. Age from 27 to 30, height about 5:10" or 11°, broadly built.

## "KILLED. 8.8.18."

I met Corporal Lundie for the first time in England in 1917. He was a personal friend of mine. We were both in "D" Company. He was a tall, well-built, handsome man about 6 feet high, and of fair complexion. I saw him for the last time after he was killed at Hamel. It was on August 9th. I cannot remember where he was buried. I did not see him taken away.

# 13th Battalion, 1613 L/Cpl A.P. Lundie, killed August 8/1918.

He was killed instantly by a shell on the right of Chipilly in front of Proyart. He was guiding a tank into action at the time. He was in B Coy.

Tall, well-built, played football with the battalion team. Came from N.S.W.

Informant states that Limite was killed on 8th Map 1918 during an attack by a bullet wound. Informant was alongside of him at the time and was him fall. He did not speak after he was hit. Limite was in Informant's section and Informant travelled over to Egypt with Limite in the S.S. "Ulycsis" in December 1914. Limits was a big man, clean shaven, about 14 stone, unsazziel, fair.

### "Killed 8,8,18."

Informant described Lundie as about 6 ft. high, medium build, very fair complexion, aged about 22. Came from Newtown. Informant states that on 8.8.18 the Battalian was in action not far from Villers Bretonneux. They hopped over at 5 a.m. At 9 a.m. they had captured the first objective and were digging in when a shell came over and instantly killed Lundie and another man. Informant was at Headquarters and did not see this happen, but later in the day saw Lundie lying where he had fellen. Informant was told that Lundie was buried where he fell.

Informant added that Lundie was a great friend of his and that he (Informant) knew Lundie's mother and sister. He was a good all-round chap and well liked and used to teach boxing to the boys.

# "Killed 8/8/1918".

Informant described Lundie as about 5'10", stout build, fair complexion, aged 26. Informant states that they both belonged to "D" Company and the same Platon. Lundie being a Secret

On the 8-8-18 the Battalion was in front of Morlancourt during the first day of the big advance which ended the war. They hopped over at daylight and about 11 a.m. when Lundie was scouking about 100 yards in front of his Platoon, and was on top of a big ridge, he was killed outright by a sniper. Informant was with the Platoon and saw Lundie fall, but could not wait to investigate as he had to keep going. Lundie was probably buried near to where he was killed. He was a particular mate of Informant's and was also well liked by his other mates.

Informent despribed Landie as about 6 ft, high, stong build, fair empireries, aged about 24, and was Informent's Scott.

Informent states that they both beisaged to D. Geopeny. On S.S.18 the Rattalian cas in assion at Manuscrt. They hopped over ut 4,20 a.m., Between 7 and 8 a.m., when they were right up to the objective and were about to take it; Londie was killed outright by a ballet. Informent was about 200 yards away and see him fall. He was carried away after Informent passed him in the advance and Informent believes that he was buried at Marcourt.

Informant added that Londie was one of the best of soldiers. He wrote to Landie's people, but does not know whether they received him letter.
