He died at the 5th C.C.S. He appeared to be getting on pretty well when I saw him there on 8-8-18. I think he was wounded near Peronne by a Machine Gun bullet in the left lung. I should describe him as slightly fair, fairly well built, about 5ft 6. He was a Signaller in D.Company.

and walked back to the R.A.P. I know nothing of his Death and
burial.
