

He was admitted to this Hospital with a very severe shell wound in right arm and in a critical condition. He did not improve and died as a result of his wound at 2.45.a.m. on the morning of the 6.10.17. He was buried in the Soldier's Cemetery near to this Hospital on the same day, his grave being duly marked and registered.

I knew L/Corporal Arthur S. Leal. Section Commander of the L. G. Section, E. Company, 6th. Platoon. I was with him on the morning of Cotober 4th. 1917, at Broodscinde Ridge. It was daybreak, and as we were going over the Tape in the attack he was hit by a shell splinter on his right shoulder. I took off his goer and bandaged him and left him in a shell hole. His Cousin, Private, Grant, B. Company, 6th. Platoon, teld me that Leal was cerried to the D/Station, and pied of Founda at Ho. 17. C. C. S. Ponnerinshe, and was buried at the Military Tounds at Ho. 17. C. C. S. Pepperinghe, and was buried at the Hilltary Cometary there. Grant is with the Unit.





He is my cousin and I naturally took considerable trouble to find out all particulars of his death and I sent them to my sunt, his mother. He died on Oct 6th, from the effects of wounds received on Oct 4th, gunshot wounds in the right shoulder. He was buried at Poperinghe behind the 16th Canadian Dressing-station. He came from Pymble, Sydney.
