The same bomb or rather two bombs (aerial torpedoes) that Banraud & Dickinson were wounded by, caused 64 casualties - 9 being killed outright and 1 other died of wounds. All the nine were buried that day at the place where the Canadians who died of gas attack are buried, near (Belgian) Hospital Elizabeth - of the nine who were killed I remember these seven men. Hopkins died of wounds next day and was brought back and buried where the others are buried.
