

officially reported Wounded and Missing 114.17, we are forwarding the following unofficial report given by 2409 Pte.Macfarlane. Which we fear is not not a very hopeful nature. He states:—"Healy was not in my coy, but I knew him as we had work together at Bullecourt on April 11th. I saw him wounded in the German first line trench. He was shot through the hip. I carried on and Healy was left. I heard that he had been put into a dugout which was blown in".
