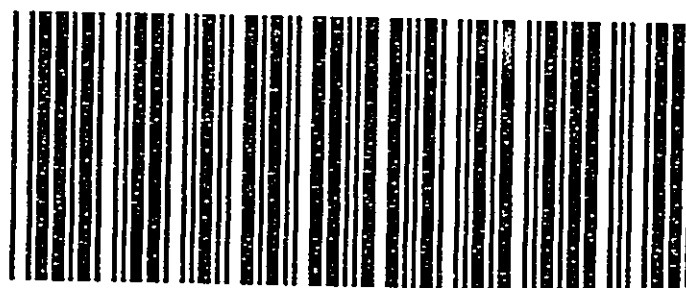

who was officially reported Missing since 16.4.17, we beg to inform you we learn from a German list dated 2.6.17, that he is a Prisoner of War interned at Limburg a/d Lahn.

officially reported Wounded and Missing 11.4.17, we are forwarding the following unofficial report given by 2409 Pte. Macfarlane, which we fear is not of a very hopeful nature. He states:-
"Healy was not in my coy, but I knew him as we had work together at Bullecourt on April 11th. I saw him wounded in the German first line trench. He was shot through the hip. I carried on and Healy was left. I heard that he had been put into a dugout which was blown in".
