These boys were in D. Co., and went out with their platoon Officer, 2nd Lt. Stuart on the 15th April, 1917, at Lagnicourt, and took up a position near the German wires and dug in. They were surrounded by the Germans and it is believed were taken prisoners of war. We went over the ground after and none of the bodies of these men were found.
