Several of my chums told me early in July that this man had been killed at Courtney's Post, near Shrapnel Gully. They had seen his body lying in front of one of our trenches there. They were advancing at the time and told me this after the charge when we were in the trenches. Fitzgibtons was about 5'7", thin, rather dark and wore a moustache.
