I know Frew, his name was Bob and he went out with me and about 18 others of D XV in an advance on 21st Aug. in Australia Gully. We then dug ourselves in and he was found to be missing. When we got back I made enquiries and was told by Cpl. Upton that Frew was all right though wounded. Later on I was told that he was missing. We held the small trench where we dug ourselves in till we were relieved by the 16th Batt the next night. This position was afterwards called "Heron's Post". He was a 6th Reinf. and was the only man of the name in D and only came up about a week before we made the advance on the 6th August.
