Witness was somgeant of No. 7 Platoon. B Coy.,
9th Batt, and soldier was in the same platoon, in charge of No. II Sect.
Witness states as follows: On B Coy entering Witness states as follows: On B Coy entering the first line trenches to right of village of Pozieres, about midnight, on July 25rd 16, a message was passed along: 9th Batt. Bombers wanted on right Gadd and I went along with bombers to the right, and shortly afterwards Gadd was killed instantaneously by a shrapnel shell.

He was hit about the stomach and legs, but was not greatly disfigured.

I was standing only a few yards away at the time. I helped to bury him in a Dug-Out in the front line. The Dug-Out was filled in with dirt afterwards. There was nothing left to distinguish the spot.

At Pozieres we were in a night attack & he was killed in the early morning of July 84th. He caught the full force of a shell. I passed by his body at mid-day & recognized him. He must have been killed instantaneously.

We kept the ground so it is most likely he was buried."

### "Killed in Action 23.7.16."
