

They were all killed within ten minutes by M.G.bukkets through the head when we were enfiladed by the Germans during their attack at about 3 p.m. on April 5th, in a gully along our side of the raiway line about a mile from the Some and about 4 miles on the left front of Riveccurt. (on the right of Albert). They were killed about 10 yards from me. Gilbert hed been wounded in the leg and was going out. I saw them buried the next evening at the bottom of the valley, the place being marked by crossesticks. Moore was a mate of mine. Tell, this about 19, came from Lismore.N.S.W. joined in March. when I saw Gilbert who had been wounded in the knee, struck by a bulle to in the head. We could do nothing for him as he was without doubt mortally wounded.
