

I saw him fall, hit by shell. He only lived a few minutes. I was with him when he died. I know nothing as to buriel. Our strock failed.

#### 以Novr.14th.1916.

He was a signaller, in C.Coy. About 7 a.m. on Novr.14th. Rust before we got the order to charge, I saw Hambrook's body in our trench, badly smashed about the trunk evidently by a chell. The bottom of the trunk was deep soft mud, and it is probable the body was involuntarily buried in the mud. He was about 18 or 19; short and alim.

Pambrook came over with me, he came from Tramba (?) in Queeneland near Ipawish. At Flers in the middle of November just before we went over a shell came and killed him instantly. He was buried just about 500 yards behind our front line. We marked his grave with a cross.
