6467 Pte. H. Fullard, 17th Battn, A.I.F. was admitted to this Hospital on the 29th October 1918, suffering from Broncho-pneumonia. He was very ill when admitted and despite the best of attention failed to pick up and died at 10 p.m. on the 5th November 1918. (He had formerly been attached to this hospital when it was at Brighton).
