#### Killed 8.10.18

#### Hilled 3.10.18.

I saw Hamilton, of 111th How. Bty. killed near me by whizz bang shell abt. 10 a.m. on the right of Ramicourt. He was hit in left arm and died from shock - he ran about 5 yds into a dugout and when we reached him he was dead. His body was taken to the wasson lines but I don't know where he was buried.

Hamilton:- Fairly tall, thin, sallow, fair, abt 20 yrs. was only with the Bty for a few weeks.

have to confirm the report of his death in action on
8.10.18. He is officially reported to have been buried in
a small cometery near Joncourt. We have also received an
unofficial report of his detah from 1570 Gnr. C.W. Porter
of the same Unit who described him as a fair young man of 19,
and stated that he was killed by concussion close to Joncourt
at about 10.a.m. on 8.10.18. and was buried in the cemetery
there on the same day.
