Dear Sir,

We are told by Headquarters that Lt. Peter McCallum and Lt. O.C.D. Gower 14th Batta. are prisoners of war in Germany and that you have received letters from them to this effect. We should be most grateful if you will send us their address in Germany, as we are anxious to forward parcels through our Prisoners of War Dept. and until we hear from you we shall be unable to do so.

You will realise therefore how much we should appreciate an early reply. If at any time you receive word of any of your Batta. as prisoners in Germany, will you be kind enough to advise us, for it is possible, as in the above instances, that we ourselves may not have heard from them or from Germany.. This will enable us to despatch their parcels more quickly.
