They were taken prisoners during the stunt on April 11th at Ballecourt. They were brothers and came from Victoria. They were both in a shell hole with me, and I was badly wounded. Fritz came and took both Hobbs' prisoners - they would not take me on account of my wound. They gave me a drink of coffee and told me that our stretcher bearers would be along soon. Fritz did not speak to the Hobbs' at all, but just took them.away. I saw it all.
