"Died of Wounds 5.11.17"

This case was hopeless from the first - gunshot wound back - a paraplegia case - paralysed from chest down. He died peacefully and without pain, and was buried at Brookwood. The brother of the girl he was engaged to (Mr. Horne, c/o Glynn Mills & Co. Bankers, Lombard St.) visited him frequently, and is writing to his people, as is also the sister of the ward.
