### Killed in action 23/12/16.

"Casual ty was killed on the 25rd December, 1916. He was killed by bullet, shot through the jaw. The bullet came out of the neck. He died within a few minutes. He did not speak again. He was buried. A cross was put over his grave."

#### Killed in action 23/12/16.

"I helped to bury casualty. He was killed on the 23rd Decembor, 1916 at Lagdabhar in Egypt. He was killed by a bullet through the jaw which entered the cheek and destroyed the face on the opposite side. He died in hour's time after he was wounded. We buried him and marked the grave on the spot. He had a formal funeral."

Informant knew A, Hairn well, both were in B Squad.together.

Hairn was killed on Dsc.23 when the brigade was taking Magdaba

Hot on Dec.2nd as put in the book. Hairn was a strong looking

chap, dark and clean shaven about 35 or 34. Home Malles, dis
trict Victoria, Profession a farmer. Informant says during the

after-noon of Dec.23rd just before we actually took the village

of Magdaba, Informant saw Hairns who was quite near him get a

bullet right through his head, he never moved or spoke. He was

killed instantaneously. Informant never actually saw Hairn's

grave but knows he was buried that night right up against the

Redoubts. About 3 weeks later while at El-Arish Informant saw

some man of the 8th Light Horse making crosses for graves, one

of which was a cross fully engraved with Hairn's name number

and date ofdeath on it.

He was in C. Squad informent gave initial correctly. On the evening of Dec: 23 during the attack on Maghdaba, informent saw Mairn get killed outright by a bullet & also saw him buried next morning where he fell his grave being fully marked with a cross on which were his name, number, & date of death.

We knew him as "Alick". He was well built, medium height. Witness and he were both in "B" Squadron.

During an attack at Maghdaba, about 15 miles from El Arish, he was hit by a bullet. Witness was 5 yards away and saw him fall, he immediately examined the body, and was satisfied he was killed instantaneously. Nairn, Capt. Higgins and Trooper Perkins, as well as the others killed the same day, were buried together, by the Squadron, a separate cross being erected over each grave.

Witness, as well as another man interviewed, assure me the correct date of the casualty was December 23rd. He was a real straight living man, and one could not meet a better in a day's walk, and he was very popular with the boys.
