I knew him well also his people, I wrote to his mother at V Clifton Hill Victoria also his wife at Carlton Victoria about the occurrence. He originally came from Warburton Victoria He was about 5'7" high nuggety ~~Build~~, Fair complexion and about 25 or 26 years of age.
