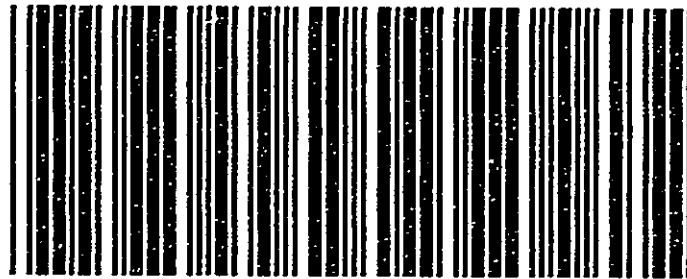

At Fleurbaix during our attack we were advancing and I was about 10 yards from Howes. He was carrying a box of bombs and a bullet struck the box, causing the bombs to explode. He was killed instantly.  
I was wounded myself so I could not say where he was buried.  
He came from Melbourne.
