We were both in 4th Bgd. 117th Bty. Had been together about 6 months.
I saw him lying badly wounded in abdomen (from shell) on his way back
after getting water from Noriel Gully and I saw him taken to D.S.
there. Was told he was sent on Vaux C.C.S. His brother (in the
1st Engineers) told us a little later he had died further on.
His mate, Gunner R.R. Cutting of 68th Unit, can give full details.
