

LIHOU. "MH" "DCM" Pte. J. 5713. KILLED/ACTION. 18.9.18. Died of Wounds." Graves V. 5689 Core. A.F.

I saw Graves, Gore and Lihou (not Lihon) of C. Coy. X. all hit by revolver bullets on the right of the village of Livergnes (possibly Longavesnes : HEH) about 6 s.m. during the hopover - they were laver the attacking an outpost at the time. Gore was hit right though body from side to side - I don't know where he died. Graves was hit through stomach - he shock hards with me and I see his die - it. through stomach - he shook hands with me and I saw him die within 50 yards of where he was hit. Lihou (was sgt in charge of Migumers at the time) was hit through the chest. I don't know about burial as we went on.

LIHOU (not Lihon), came over with me, left Sydney 4.5.16. in Clan Mo

Gillwiay.

Gora:- Dark, thin, about 28/30 yrs. married man, with a wife in Sydney.

Graves:-abt.5'8 or 9, 22 yrs. Came from Rochdale, Sydney. I know his people and have written to his mother - he has a brother in 45th Bttn. He came over with me. Left sydney 4.5.16. in Clan McGillelay. 18th Rits for 13th Btn. He was a coy runner but was attached to X platoon for that stunt.

Informant described Libou as about 5 ft 6 in. high, slight build, fair complexion, aged about 33 or 24. Feld the D.C.H. and , J.

Informant states that they both belonged to C. Company, of which Lihou was Lewis Gun Sergenst. On 18.9.18 the Enttelion was advancing on La Vorguier to the left of St. Quentin. They hopped ever at 4.30 n.m. About half an hour later when they had advanced about 2 kilometres and before they got to the objective, Lihou was hit by machine gun fire while he was rushing an enemy madiine gun posse. Informant was noout 100 yards from him and saw him fall, but was not able to go over to him as he had to keep going. He never saw Lihou again, but heard that he was taken to a Casualty Clearing Station and died there. He was probably buried at the Casualty Clearing Station either at Peronne or Doingt about 2 kilometres away.

according to Informant Lihou was a very popular chap and

a good soldier.

Informant described Lihou as about 5'8" high, medium build, aged 25/30, christian name "ames", was a Sergeant when killed.

Cn 18-9-18 the Battalion was in action near Le Verquier on the read to St. Quentin. They hopped ever at 5.30 a.m. They gained their first objective and about 9-30 a.m. when near collins Copse, on the way to the second objective, some of the Battalion were held up by a machine gun Posse. Linou rushed the Posse on his own and was hit and fell across the wire, being appared and willed outright. Informant was about 50 yards away on ently killed outright.
