Your letter of 26th July re above deceased to hand, but we regret we are unable to supply you with any information from this unit. The books containing records of this man have been forwarded to Base Records Office 3rd Echelon, Rouen, France. Communication with the Officer-in-Charge Base Records would no doubt enable you to obtain the required information. All men who died in our dressing station during August 1916 were buried at Warloy Communal Cemetery Extension, Warloy, Baillon, Somme.
