"Killed. 11/4/17."

Jordan was in "A" Company, 4th platoon, with me. 2293 was his No.; he was tall and dark, about 30 years old. He was killed instantly by a shell which exploded quite close to him, in April, 1917, at Hermies. I saw it happen, and was only about 15 yards away at the time, and was lucky not to be wounded by the same shell. I do not know where he was buried, but I am sure he was killed outright.
