Jones was killed on 6th. Aug. whilst taking rations up to the 14th. Bn. I was one of the party. A piece of shrapnel hit him in the chest and he died instantly. We had no chance to bury him at the time and I know he was just put over the top. This happened at Pozieres.

I saw him killed while we were on a ration party, taking rations up to the 14th. Bn. lines. A piece of shell struck him in the side and killed him outright. I saw his dead body which had been left in the sap. This occurred at Pozieres on 7th. Aug.
