Witness knew a man named Hutchwaite in the 4th Bn. His initials was G and he came over with the 6th Rfts. He was a mate of the witness. Witness says he knows Hutchwaite took part in the attack at Lone Pine on 7/8/15. Witness saw him just before it. The casualties were very heavy and witness does not know what became of Hutchwaite. He has not seen him since.
