RE ENQUIRY

"I picked up the Wallet I now hand you at Mexzine, 10 miles from Amiens about a month ago. There were five bottles wrapped in blankets ready for burial at the 11th Field Dressing Station and their kits all together near the Salvage Dump. I took the wallet out of a haversack. I could not find any trace of the name of the owner"

The wallet has been sent to the Australian Red Cross Society, London

Evidently from the letter and card enclosed in the wallet the name of the man reported on was Ivan L. Kelly, but the number of the battalion is not mentioned, but this could be ascertained from the brother: Hubert L.C. Kelly, 1952 of the 18th Bn. Pioneers, A.I.F.
