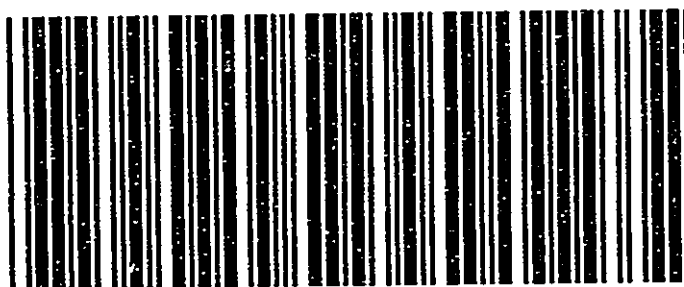

Killed in action 8-8-1915

I saw him killed by a M.G. Bullet in the head about 6 or 7 a.m. on the morning of August 8th, in what was known as the wheat patch. Kelly was fair headed, about 5'6, 11 stone, came over on the "Ceramic" from Melbourne, on the 22-12-1914. He was known among the boys as "Our Miss Kelly"

From all accounts I do not think he was buried as the ground was not retained.
