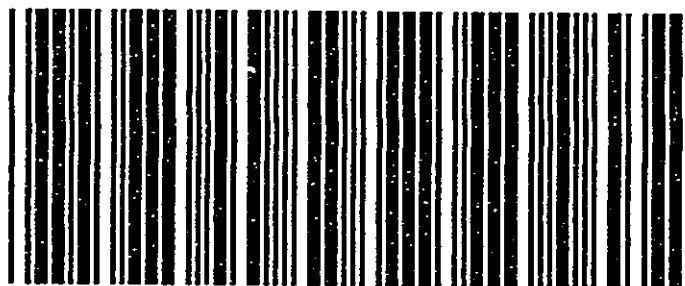

No. 1068 J.H. Grainger was wounded at Lagnicourt by shell fire, and died, being buried at the Bty. position at Lagnicourt. A Cross is erected with his name on. I saw him hit, present at burial, and have seen the grave, with Cross. There are two Crosses with several names on. Those I remember are:-
