

Sitness knew his number, and says he was killed at Lone Pine. The Quarter Haster had his rifle and remarked to witness that Holden would want that no more as he was dead. Holden was a good shot, and used to win prizes. He was an Englishman, and fairly well educated. He enlisted at Sydney. He was lively, with a well educated English voice. He stood about 5 ft 7 ins., was elean shaven, dark and about 22 years old.
