Dear Mrs. Deakin

Just a few lines tonight sorry I did not have
time to call to see you today only up a few hours
I have not received any cards for a week or more
& thought I'd better let you know in case they were
going astray. I suppose the new lists will be out
any day now. Enclosed a little note received from
Australia from a Melbourne young lady perhaps
you might be able to give some information.

The war news is splendid & our boys are in the
thick of it. I will try to see you shortly every
good night I'm feeling life - life glad to say
kind regards

Dear Mr. Amos I am sending you the
address of another friend who has been
reported killed in action nearly 2 years
ago. Yet in one of the Sydney papers
his photo appeared and was said to
be taken 9 months ago. His people enquired
about him and they couldn't give any
more news than he was convicted
in England. I thought his brain might
be affected and he couldn't tell anything
about himself.

find anything about him.

In reply to your enquiry concerning - 3832 Pte. C.R.
KING. 6th Battalion. A.I.F. We beg to inform you that he is
officially reported Killed in Action on 26-7-16 and is buried
3 miles N.E. of Albert, South of Pozieres, the map reference
of his grave being 24140 G. We therefore assume that the
photograph, in the Sydney paper, to which you refer, must be that of
some other man or one of Pte. King taken some time before his death.

Trusting that this information will be of some assistance
to you.
