Jeffers was observer and 2nd Lieut Yeel was Pilot.
They both left Premont about September 19th 1918 on a
photographic stunt. They had an escort but getting into a
cloud, they got separated and were not seen again. Jeffers
had only been out of Hospital more than a month when he went
on this stunt. 5ft.7". Thin - Reddish Complexion, Age 24/30.
