We were on the Messines Front in support lines. On the night of the 15th Ar 16th August several of our Plat. including King and myself, were on a ration party. As we were returning, King was shot through the stomach. It was by M.G. Fire. I was close by and saw him fall. Pte. Neble, B Co. 8 Pl., carried him to the D/S. He was reported D/w the next day. His grave has been seen by some of our Plat. I am afraid I cannot recollect their names. King was in B Co. 8 Pl.

All the information I know concerning 6999 Pte.S.E.King is Ail the information i know concerning over reash. Aing is dark complexion, height about 5.6", weight 9 to 10 stone Harried man from Queensland. 23rd Reinforcement 15th Battn. 8th Platoon, B. Company. He was wounded at Hessines on or about the day of the 15th Aug. 1917. He was hit with a Mahine Gun bullet through the left side a few inches below the heart. He was then immediately taken to the dressing station. He died a few days extended was boried in a soldiers cometery not far from days after and was buried in a soldiers cemetery not far from Neuve Eglise.
