Jackson was from Baconsfield, W.Australia, and one of my M.G. He was knocked by M.G. bullet and died some few days later at a C.C.S., I expect it was No. 5 Hear Amiens. I did not see casualty, which happened while he was in an advanced party looking over the ground before we went up at Villers-Bretonneux. It was reported back.
