"Died of Wounds 5-5-18"

Re Pte. Jackman. He was admitted to this C.C.S. on 4-5-18 suffering from Shell Wound of the Right Tibia. His condition on admission was critical and gave little hope of recovery. He died on the day following admission. He was buried in the local Military Cemetery.

Jackman was a dark, married man aged 38, about 5 ft.8. He was wounded by a shell at Villers Bretonneux. There was ~~in~~ no attack. He died at 20 C.C.S. and was buried in the military cemetery at Vindecourt. A cross marks the grave which I have seen.

"Died of Wounds 5-5-18"

Jackson was from Baconsfield, W. Australia, and one of my M.G. He was knocked by M.G. bullet and died some few days later at a C.C.S., I expect it was No. 5 near Amiens. I did not see casualty, which happened while he was in an advanced party looking over the ground before we went up at Villers-Bretonneux. It was reported back.

I was told by Pte.J.W.Johnson (now L/Cpl) that Jackman was wounded by a shell while walking through the village of Villers Bretonneux, and died in Hospital. I do not know where he was buried, but the hospital was No 1 Australian General. Ronen.

I know Jackman was very badly wounded at Villers Bretonneux and also that he died at the dressing station. Word was sent from Medical Officer to Battalion Headquarters. The ground was not held.
