NO ENQUIRY

I saw him fall at Ypres on the morning (daylight) of the 20th Sept. 1917. Pte. H. Mafford, 6382, of the same section took the gun from him. He was badly hit and only just breathing. I do not think he could live. He was in a hot corner. Machine gun and shell fire were very heavy. I cannot say where he was buried. He held the ground.
