He had a low No. At Ridgewood Cemetery on the Ypres Sector, I have seen a grave with a cross over it bearing Sgt. Roscoe's eane, initial and Number. It also stated that he was killed in action. The man I knew was a fair man of medium height and slim. He had a slight moustache. He would be between 30 and 35 years of age.
