Col. Mahaffey was killed by shell fire. He was hit in the neck by a piece of shell which severed the jugular vein and bled to death before anything could be done to save him. He was on an advanced out-post at the time, which was inaccessable during the day-time. Cpl. Mahaffey was 6'1" in height, dark hair and dark complexion. He left Australia 31. 3.16 with the 11th Reinforcements. Next of kin Father - Andrew Mahaffey Down St., Boonah, Queensland.

I was on a listening post with Cpl. Mahaffey (25 B, VIII) about Har. 24th., in a crater between the German lines & our own on the Arras front, when a whizz-bang exploded about 3 P.H. A piece caught Kahaffey in the neck & he died about 3 minutes after. I did all I could to he him. He could not speak. There were 8 of us with him at the time. I did all I could to help Pta. Williams was one, also Pta. Tiny Powler who died of wounds from the same Shell. I buried Cpl. Mahhaffey in the crater. There was probably a cross put up later."

I went up to fetch Fowler in the same crater who was with him we took the wounded to Mory. I had to leave Mahaffey lying dead there.

He was sent forward with 4 others for observation purposes to a mine crater, about 200 yards from Fritz line just in advance of the Sugar Hill, about 2 miles past Bapaume and they were entirely at the mercy of Fritz, and Mahaffey was killed instantly by a whize bang. He was buried near there.



We are not sure if the Pte Williams referred to was yourself, but if so, we should be very grateful for any informatical you could send us concerning Pte Hahaffey and would also be pleased if you could aid a short personal description or any points that would help us to prove his identity, such as occupation in civil life, previous to unlistment, home twwn in Australia, if an original man or a reinforcement etc.

If you are not the Pte Williams referred to, perhaps you would be kind enoughto send on our enquiry to the Battn, where it might reach the right Pte Williams.

We trust you are now nearly well again and will soon be able to enjoy your furlough.
