

## "Killed 29.9.18."

The RUSS I knew had been a Drill Sergeant in Aussie. About 25 years, short, dark, slight, about 6ft.6ins. He was married about a fortnight before leaving Aussie. On the 29th September we were following Yanks near village of Biny on Hindenberg line. We just got through our forward guns when Russ got bullet (M.G.) in heart. He was about 50 yards sway when he got it. I saw his dead body. He was buried by first line transport. I did not see his grave. Russ left Aussie with 32nd Reinforcements transferred to 43rd.
